1. For classes I to VIII, there will be two terms in an academic year. Term -1 is from April to September and Term 2 is from October to March.
2. The Scholastic Area Assessment of Term -1 in all major subjects is 100 Marks which includes
 - i. Periodic Test-1 (10 Marks)
 - ii. Periodic Test-2/ half Yearly Examination (60 Marks)
 - iii. Internal Assessment (30 Marks)
3. The Scholastic Area Assessment of Term-2 in all major subjects is also of 100 Marks which includes
 - i. Periodic Test-3 (10 Marks)
 - ii. Periodic Test-4/Annual Examination (60 Marks)
 - iii. Internal Assessment (30 Marks)

The Syllabus of the Annual Examination will not include the syllabus taught for Half Yearly Examination.

4. The performance of students in scholastic areas in all major subjects will be reflected in terms of marks as well as grades (8 Point scale) in the Report Card. The final percentage of Scholastic Area in each major subject will be calculated from marks obtained out of 100 Marks.
5. The Performance of a student in scholastic areas in all minor subjects will be reflected in terms of grades (3- point scale in the Report Card for Term -1 & Term -2 separately.
6. Internal Assessment of 30 marks for each Term is based mostly on core competencies desired in each subject. Under each competency, the parameters/tools to be used to test the competency are mentioned below.
